IMPORTANT

RAB fixtures must be wired in accordance with the National Electrical Code and all applicable local codes. Proper grounding is required for safety. THIS PRODUCT MUST BE INSTALLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPLICABLE INSTALLATION CODE BY A PERSON FAMILIAR WITH THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF THE PRODUCT AND THE HAZARDS INVOLVED.

WARNINGS:

- Risk of electrical shock. Disconnect power at fuse or circuit breaker before installing or servicing.
- To prevent early lamp failure, lamp should only be installed in operating environments ranging between -30°C and +40°C (-22°F and +104°F).
- No user serviceable parts inside. To avoid electrical shock do not disassemble product.
- Risk of fire or electric shock, LED Retrofit Kit installation requires knowledge of luminaires electrical systems. If not qualified, do not attempt installation. Contact a qualified electrician.
- Risk of fire or electric shock, Install this kit only in luminaires that have the construction features and min dimensions shown in below and where the input rating of the retrofit kit does not exceed the input rating of the luminaire.
- Do not make or alter any open holes in an enclosure of wiring or electrical components during kit installation
- To prevent wiring damage or abrasion, do not expose wiring to edges of sheet metal or other sharp objects.
- Installers should not disconnect existing wires from lampholder terminals to make new connections at lampholder terminals, Instead installers should cut existing lampholder leads away from the lampholder and make new electrical connections to lampholder lead wires by employing applicable connectors.
- This retrofit kit is accepted as a component of a luminaire where the suitability of the combination shall be determined by authorities having jurisdiction.
- This device is not intended for use with emergency exits.
- This retrofit kits suitable for wet locations luminaires specified as below: Type Non IC; Type IC; Covered ceiling; Uncovered ceiling. Installers should examine all parts that are not intended to be replaced by the retrofit kit for damage and replace any damaged parts prior to installation of the retrofit kit.

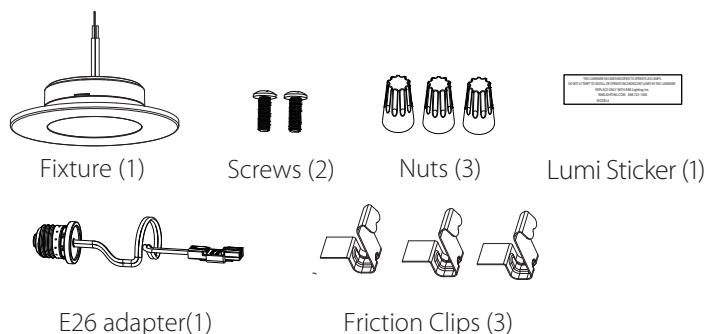

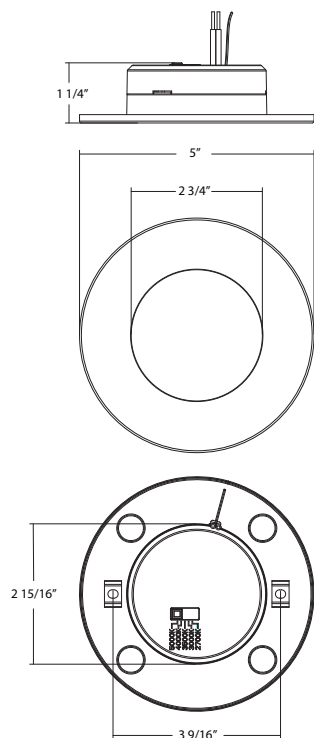
TOOLS NEEDED

Installation with J-BOX/Existing Housing

A screwdriver is needed for installation.

Compatible with 4" metal octagon or 4" plastic j-boxes with min. 3.2" clearance.

Installation with Existing Housing

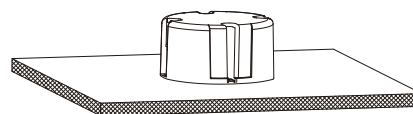

INSTALLATION WITH J-BOX

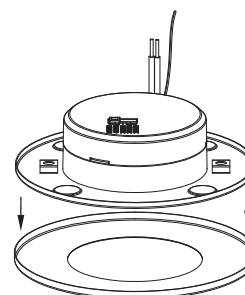
1. Make sure power is turned off and the J-Box fixed on the ceiling surface. (Fig.1)

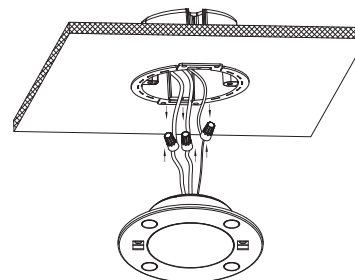
2. Take off the existing magnetic trim from the fixture. (Fig.2)

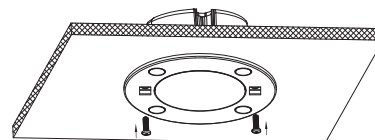
3. Select desired color temperature. Make sure live (black) and neutral (white) wires, ground (yellow&green) wire are accessible from J-Box. Wire nut live (black) wire with fixture black wire and wire nut neutral (white) wire with fixture white wire. Wire nut ground (yellow&green) with fixture ground (yellow&green) wire. Carefully tuck wires inside J-Box. (Fig.3)

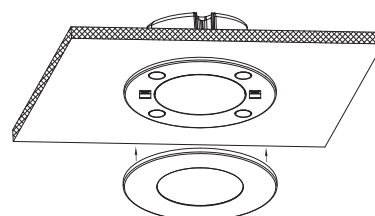
4. Push the fixture without trim into the J-box. Secure and lock the fixture with the screws. (Fig.4)

5. Fasten the magnetic trim to the fixture. Magnetic color trims is optional as optional accessory. (Fig.5)

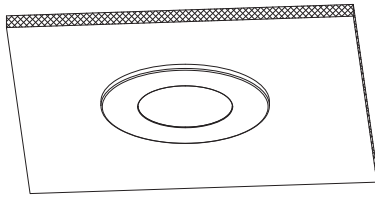

6. Make sure the fixture is flush with the ceiling. (Fig.6)

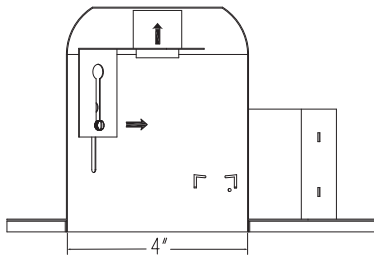

INSTALLATION WITH EXISTING HOUSING

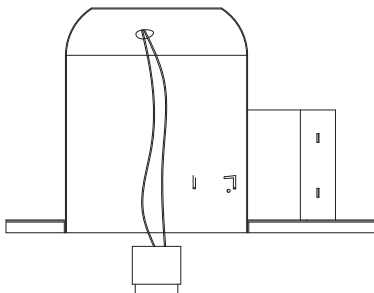
1. Make sure the power is turned off at the source to the recessed housing(s) that you are installing the fixture(s) in. Remove existing trim and CFL, or Incandescent bulbs. Unscrew the screws on socket bracket, push bracket upward to the top location. (Fig.7)

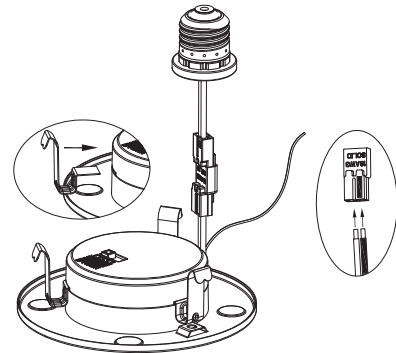
2. Remove existing socket mounting plate from the recessed housing and then remove lamp socket from the plate. (Fig.8)

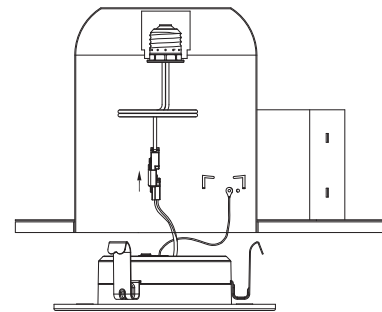
3. Select desired color temperature. Fasten the friction clips into the fixture. (The figure shown below by the arrow is the way to fix three friction clips.) Plug live (black) and neutral (white) wires into E26 base adapter. (Fig.9)

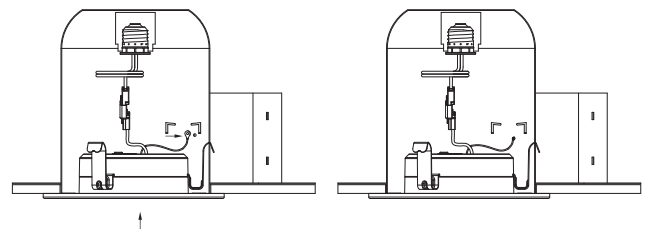
4. Screw E26 base adapter into socket in recessed housing. Plug E26 base cable connection into the recessed housing. (Fig.10)

5. Secure fixture ground (yellow&green) wire to the recessed housing. Carefully route wires into fixture, simply slide the trim and metal friction clips into the housing for tight fit. (Fig.11)

6. Push the LED trim into the housing until flush with ceiling. (Fig.12)
